

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM YOUR REPUBLICAN CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS

Subject: We Need Your Vote for Paul Lott this Saturday, March 16

We are writing with an **urgent** request for your time this Saturday, March 16, to help us elect Paul Lott as the next chair of the Loudoun County Republican Committee (LCRC).

In November 2023, you helped us get elected or re-elected to our respective offices. Working as a team, we were successful in ensuring that all five Constitutional Officers in Loudoun County are Republicans.

Unfortunately, we were not supported by our current LCRC chair, Scott Pio. He pledged to raise thousands of dollars to help us and other Republicans running for local office, but this did not happen. While a substantial sum of money was raised by LCRC, most of it went to pay for lavish social events and business expenses, instead of helping Republican candidates.

Even more disappointing, **the current chair, Scott Pio, repeatedly made unilateral decisions on behalf of the LCRC that harmed Republican candidates and Party unity.**

While the five of us were fortunate on Election Day last year, 18 of our 28 Republican candidates lost.

For the past two years, we have given Scott Pio a chance to be an effective LCRC chair, to advance our shared objectives, and to win elections in Loudoun County.

He has failed, and now it is time for a change. Electing Paul Lott as our new LCRC chair represents the beginning of that change.

We campaigned with Paul and other Republican candidates last year and we are impressed with his commitment, conservatism, and collaborative spirit. We also know that **Paul will be a team player.**

It is a lot to ask of you to vote this Saturday, but it is critically important that you do. Your vote for Paul Lott will help unite our Republican Party and set the course for future victories.

To vote on Saturday, you only need to be a registered voter in Loudoun County with a photo ID. You do NOT need to be a member of LCRC. All voting is at a single location – the 10th District Republican Headquarters at 20098 Ashbrook Place in Ashburn. **You can show up, vote quickly, and leave.** There is no other obligation at all.
